Borton class visit to The London Eye on Thursday 4th December 2025

As part of our English curriculum next term, we are reading 'London Eye Mystery' and we have arranged a trip to The London Eye (with a Thames River Cruise included in the package). The cost of the trip is £19.75 which includes a trip on the London Eye, a River Cruise and train fares. Please make payment via the SchoolMoney app.

The children will need to be dropped at Marden train station no later than 8:40am (train departs at 8:55am) and picked up again from Marden train station at 3:30pm.

<u>Please note we will all be departing on the 8:55am train and cannot wait for late-comers due to our booking slot on the London Eye.</u>

If your Borton child has a sibling in another class, you are welcome to drop the sibling to school at 8:25am on this day to enable you to get to Marden train station before 8:40am or please liaise with other parents to share lifts.

All children will need a packed lunch from home on that day; please use disposable bags rather than lunch boxes to make your child's backpack as light as possible, as they will be walking from the train station to the London Eye. Please do not pack any fizzy drinks, chocolate/sweets or any foods which contain nuts. All children should wear school uniform and comfortable shoes/trainers.

In order to secure a place on the trip, please make payment via School Money no later than Friday 28th November 2025. If you would prefer that your child didn't attend this trip, please let the Office know as soon as possible.
