Headteacher News

Gosh! What a week it has been for you trying to navigate the road closure and ensure your children were in school. I appreciate that for many of you a long diversion was necessary so thank you for your patience.

The children have been so excited this week with the new play and imaginative opportunities which have been provided for by the Redhill Trust. A big thank you goes to Mr and Mrs Hawes who spent the weekend erecting the wooden structures. We successfully applied for a grant and the charity kindly donated over £4000. We have put this money directly into purchasing reading fluency books as well as buying a shop, climbing frames, balancing kits and a playground meeting hut. We could never have provided all this from our school budget so we are exceptionally grateful to Redhill. We are already seeing the impact as the children use their imagination and enhance their social skills. Of course, their spending skills were tested too earlier this week with the fruit shop. It is a sign of the times that children struggle to recognise coins, add up and work out change when they rarely see or use cash. One child spoke about cents rather than pounds and pence and another asked if the shop accepted cards!







Thank you to those parents who came to the Phonics workshop and those who attended the SENCo Social on 'Helping Your Child Manage Big Emotions'. Mrs Seal, Mrs Wichall and Rebecca, our school counsellor, are so keen to support you.



It was National Poetry Day this week. To celebrate, every child participated by writing group or individual poems which they then posted through letterboxes in Hunton. The children loved posting and writing for a purpose to brighten someone's day and we have received phone calls and emails from the recipients saying how happy they were to receive a poem through their door.


