



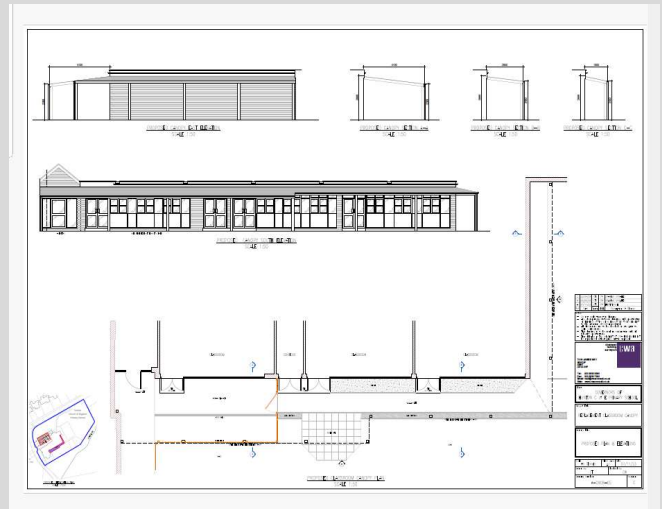

## Headteacher News
